What is a Men's Shed?

It's a communal workshop, which provides a place for guys to work together, to learn together, and have fun together. A cross between the Cheers Bar, the Generation Game, and DIY SOS.

It's mainly kitted out with woodwork tools, and you can bring your own projects or work on projects for our community. You can also share your skills, or even learn some new ones.

The one in Wareham is opening in May 2018, and is part of a global movement. We belong to the UK Men's Shed Association (<https://menssheds.org.uk>), and are one of about 450 sheds open in the UK.

They're catching on as there aren't



many good social spaces for guys out there.

All men over 18 years old are welcome, irrespective of age, skills, or income.

What is happening here?

We are renting a workshop from an adult day centre for Thursday afternoons (1 to 4pm) and Friday mornings (9.30 to 12.30pm). Each session lasts 3 hours, with a chance to eat your sandwiches with other shedders before / after.

Each session will have a host to welcome, and you'll be shown how to use the different tools safely, and will be able to use many of the materials laid on.


We'll also be collecting different commissions and community jobs to work on together—so bring your own or come ready to help.

How much is it?

We are charging an annual membership fee of £40 and a per session fee of £5. This covers our rent, insurance, materials and some tools.

However, we also have bursaries available for those who can't afford this—we want to be accessible to all guys who would benefit from the social and practical space.
